“Free health care because everyone deserves to be treated.”



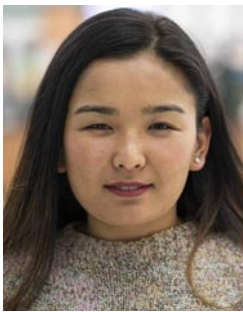
**Jacob James, aka Mr. Africa, 22**
